New Tronix Aircon Timer equipped with IR Sensor. Operate ACT-20 II using any TV remote control.



OPERATE ACT20 MANUALLY

1. Plug the Tronix Aircon Timer into a 220V electrical outlet. The Tronix Aircon Timer will indicate a zero on its digit LED display.
2. Plug the aircon's power cord into the Tronix Aircon Timer's aircon socket.
3. Press the "Timer Set" to turn the Aircon Timer on.
4. Repeatedly press the "Timer Set" button until desired time of operation is met. The timer selection is from 1 - 9 hours aircon operation, and dash sign for continuous.
5. After selection, ACT20 will activate its power on delay feature to protect the aircon's compressor. During this phase, ACT20 will display "d".
6. Power on delay will be for 3 - 5 mins.
7. The aircon and ACT20 will resume to its full operation mode after the power on delay.
8. ACT20 will automatically turn off 30 mins after the set time lapsed.
9. If an electric fan is plugged into the ACT20 fan outlet and is switched on, the electric fan will automatically turn on once the ACT20 timer lapsed.
10. To turn off ACT20, select 0 from the time selection.
